CAPITAL MARKET NEWS

The Commission

With the enactment of the Securities and Exchange Commission Act, 1993 (Act XV of 1993) on 8 June 1993, the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) was established as a capital market regulator in Bangladesh. The objectives of the Commission are furnished below:

- Ensuring proper issuance of securities,
- Protection of the interest of investors in securities,
- Development of the capital and securities markets and,
- Regulation of the capital and securities markets in Bangladesh.

Market Performance :

In recent years, due to persistent efforts of the Commission and stakeholders, significant improvements have been made in protecting investors interest and boosting confidence of investors in capital market. These improvements are taken place due to introduction of automated trading, electronic registration and transfer of securities, simplifying rules and regulation and notifying guidelines on corporate governance on comply or explain basis and requiring employment of compliance officers at firms level.

The above measures have created an investment friendly atmosphere in the capital market and in the meantime, positive impact has been noticed in both primary and secondary market. Government has started offloading its shares through capital market. So far, two state owned companies have offloaded portion of their shares on the stock exchanges. As a result the depth of securities market and daily turnover of securities transactions have increased to a significant extent.

During January-March 2007 period the total issued capital of all listed securities with the Dhaka Stock Exchange Ltd. amounted to Tk.1,53,603 million registering an increase of 29.69% over the previous Quarter's Tk.1,18,437 million. Similarly the said figure of the Chittagong Stock Exchange Ltd. amounted to Tk.75,563.45 million during January-March 2007 accounting an increase of 9.01% over the previous Quarter's Tk 69,315.37 million. The market capitalization of all listed securities of Dhaka Stock Exchange Ltd. and Chittagong Stock Exchange were Tk.4,05,493 million and TK 3,27,838 million at the end of January-March 2007 period as compared to TK.3,23,368 million and Tk.2,67,480 million in the corresponding period of October-December 2006.

Activities of the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) during January-March 2007 Quarter are given below :

Meeting of Advisory Committee Held :

The meeting of Advisory Committee of Securities and Exchange Commission held at SEC Conference Room on February 28, 2007. The meeting was chaired by Mr. Faruq Ahmad Siddiqi Chairman, SEC. The meeting emphasized on increasing of supply of good securities including mutual funds, enhancing the capacity of capital market intermediaries and SEC, simplifying regulations, etc. Among others, Additional Secretary, Ministry of Finance, Economist Professor Abu Ahmad, Managing Director- ICB, President- FBCCI, President-DSE, President-CSE, President-DCCI, President-CCCI were present in the meeting.

Investors' Education Program Held :

SEC conducts Investors' Education Program on regular basis. Such programs were held during this quarter twice a month where 82 investors attended. In these programs focus was made on how to invest in primary and secondary market and regulatory measures to maintain honest, transparent, efficient and orderly market. The investors also informed about the rights of shareholders so that they could exercise their due roles as an informed investor.

Training Program for Authorized Representatives Held :

As a part of registration requirement training programs for authorized representative of the member of the Dhaka and Chittagong Stock Exchanges were held on 22-23 April and 4 -5 April, 2007 in the DSE and SEC Conference Room respectively, where 66 authorized representatives attended. Senior officials of SEC, DSE and CSE conducted the said training highlighting various aspects of capital market including relevant securities laws.

| Dhaka Stock Exchange Ltd. (DSE) |

Delegation of Dhaka Stock Exchange Ltd. Met Honourable Finance Adviser :

A Delegation of Dhaka Stock Exchange Ltd. member met Honourable Finance Adviser of the Caretaker Government Dr. A B Mirza Azizul Islam on January 17, 2007. Senior Vice President Mr Ahmad Rashid Lali led the DSE Delegation and they invited the Honourable Finance Adviser to visit Dhaka Stock Exchange. The Honourable Adviser expressed that the Government will take steps to bring all the profitable state-owned companies and mobile phone companies in the capital market for increasing supply of securities as well as widening the alternative investment opportunities of investors.

DSE Senior Vice President attended the SAFE meeting :

A Two-day meeting of South Asian Federation of Exchanges (SAFE) held in Karachi, Pakistan on January 25, 2007. Mr. Ahmad Rashid Lali, Senior Vice President of DSE and Vice Chairman SAFE attended the meeting. The SAFE signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) to launch a joint South Asian Index at the meeting. SAFE member countries were working on this project for last six years. Formal launch of the index was expected soon since work had almost been completed.

DSE Arranged Workshop on 'Securities Rules and Regulations' :

DSE arranged a workshop on securities rules and regulations on February 13, 2007 for company secretaries of the listed companies at DSE Board Room. The workshop was addressed by Mr. Abdullah Bokhari, President DSE. SEC Chairman Mr. Faruk Ahmed Siddiqi distributed certificates among the participants in the workshop. Among others Mr. Mohammad Ali Khan, Member SEC, Mr Abdullah Bokhari, President DSE and Chief Executive Officer of DSE Mr Salahuddin Ahmed Khan were present in the program.

Election of Board of Directors of DSE Held :

The election of Board of Directors of DSE held on March 15, 2007 where Mr. Md. Abdullah Bokhari and Mr. Ahmad Rashid Lali have been re-elected as the President and Senior Vice President and Mr. Sharif Ataur Rahman has been elected as the Vice President of the Dhaka Stock Exchange Ltd..

- Out of total 15 Share Scam cases of 1996, two cases are now pending before the Honorable Supreme Court, Appellate Division, nine cases before the Honorable Supreme Court, High Court Division and rest four cases are pending before the Metropolitan Session Judge Court, Dhaka.
- Under securities law four Certificate cases have been filed against the Directors of four Companies to recover the penalty imposed upon them by the Commission during the period January-March, 2007.

DSE & CSE SCENARIO

Capital Market : As of 31 March 2007 the total issued capital of all listed securities of Dhaka Stock Exchange was TK 1,53,603 million (US\$ 2,231.95 million) which was TK 1,18,437 million (US\$ 1,711.52 million) on 31 December 2006. In Chittagong Stock Exchange the total issued capital on 31 March 2007 was TK 75,563.45 million (US\$ 1,111.23 million) which was TK.69,315.37 million (US\$ 990.22 million) on 31 December 2006.

Stock Market Operation : During January-March 2007 quarter the total turnover in Dhaka Stock Exchange was 901 million securities valuing TK. 50,111.01 million (US\$ 726.2 million)

In the same period the total turnover in Chittagong Stock Exchange was 233.07 million securities amounting to TK. 10,822.39 million (US\$ 159.15 million) .

Market Capitalization : Total market capitalization of all securities listed with the Dhaka Stock Exchange was TK.4,05,493 million (US\$ 5,892 million) as on 31 March 2007 compared to TK 3,23,368 million (US\$ 4673 million) as on 30 December 2006.

In the Chittagong Stock Exchange total market capitalization of all securities was TK.3,27,838 million (US\$.4,821.15 million) as on 31 March 2007 compared to TK 2,67,480 million (US\$ 3,821.14 million) as on 31 December 2006.

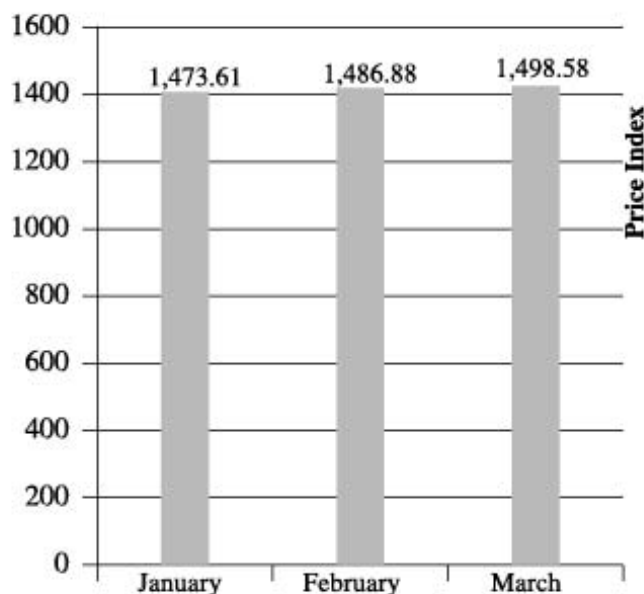

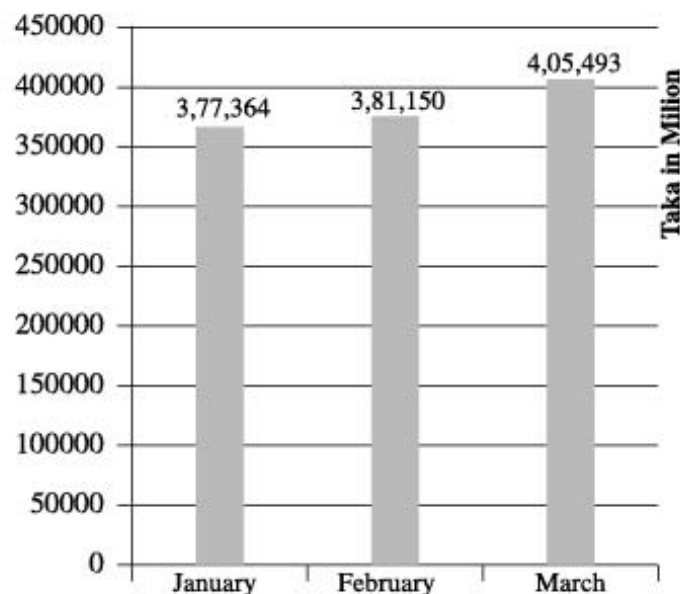

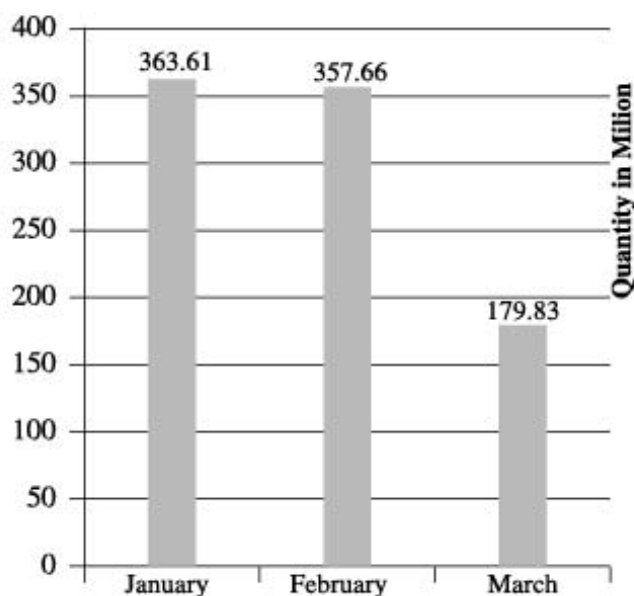
All Share Price Index



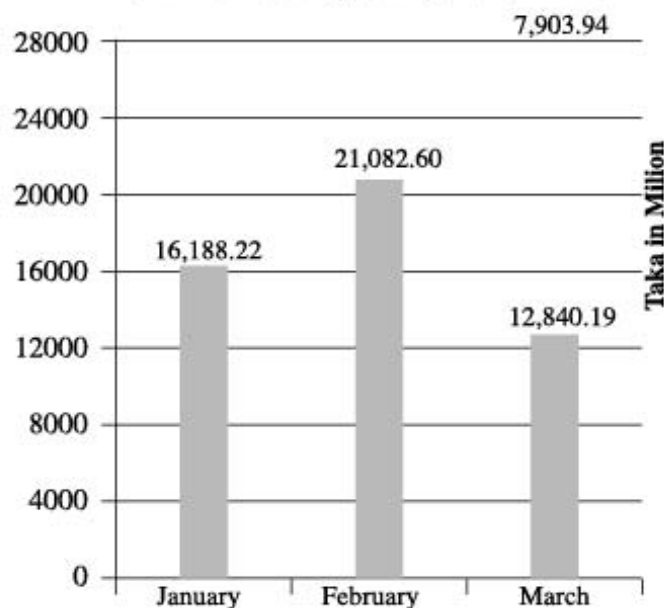
Market Capitalization

Total Turnover (Value) of Securities

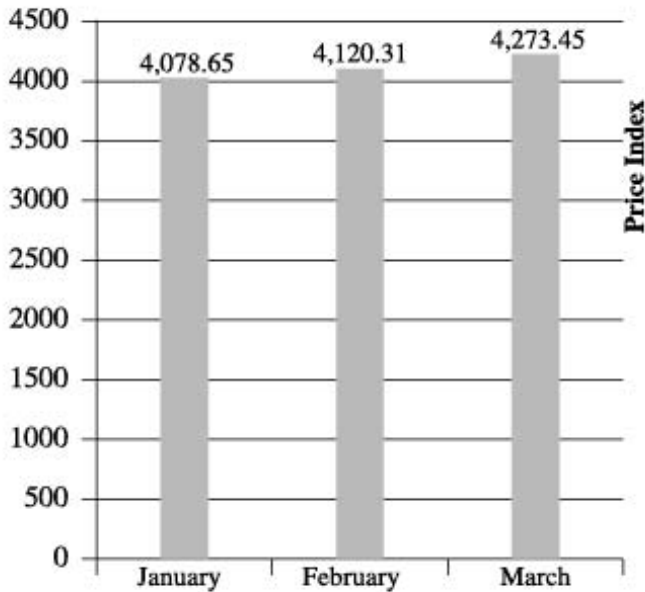

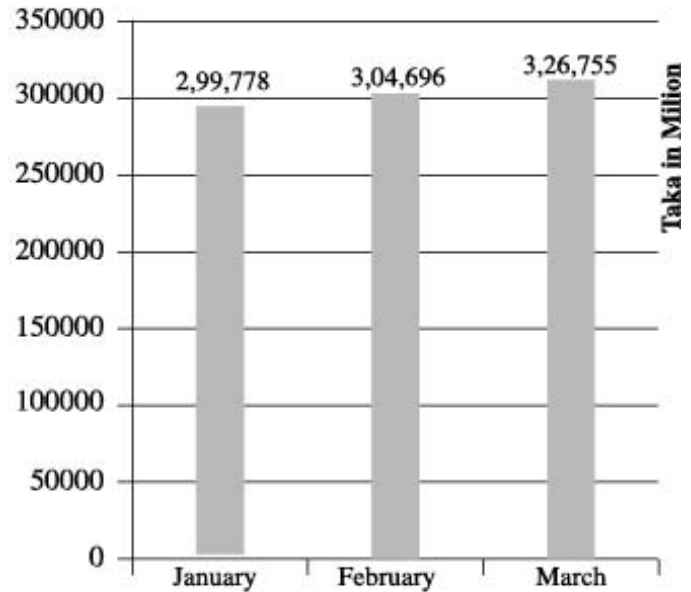

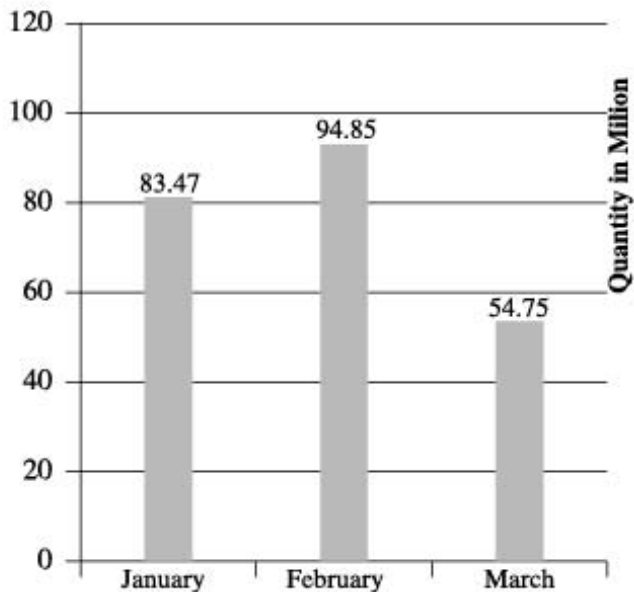
All Share Price Index



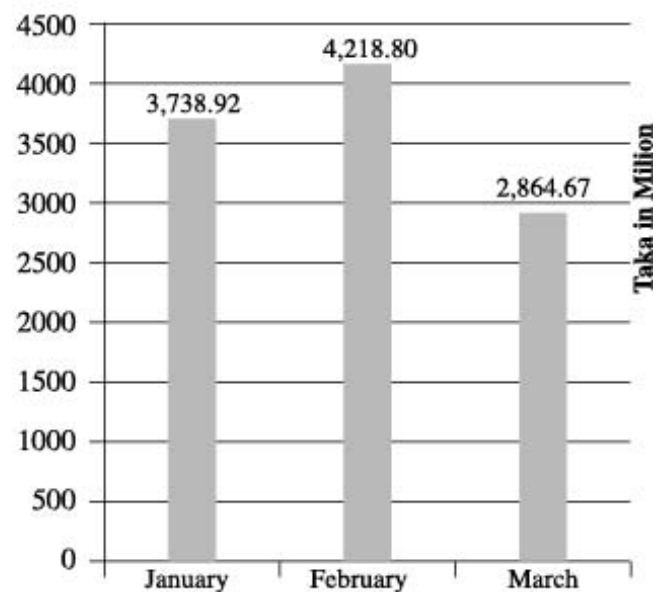
Market Capitalization
